Of course, when researchers study infants and toddlers as a group, various norms may be established, but determining average ages for the initial appearance of certain abilities does not mean that the figures represent a distinct and precise timetable. The standards resulting from such studies are merely statistical concepts; they are not intended to describe something that routinely occurs in the real world. In fact, if researchers come up with a typical rate and pattern of progress based upon 100 children, there is a low likelihood that the development of any one of those children will match every detail of the collective description. For this reason, pediatricians, psychologists and educators usually do not like to pinpoint the expected appearance of new abilities. Instead, they prefer to offer reasonable ranges. Nonetheless, when translating research results into lists and charts, considerations of economy and convenience sometimes cause this notion to get lost. As a result, parents often receive the erroneous impression that the designations of what is normal are far more rigid than they actually are. What is important to remember is that the established milestones can provide a general picture of development during infancy and toddlerhood, but they cannot provide a precise blueprint for the progress of any particular child. Although lists and charts tend to describe it in a concise and organized manner, the fact is that early development is never a neat and orderly affair.
