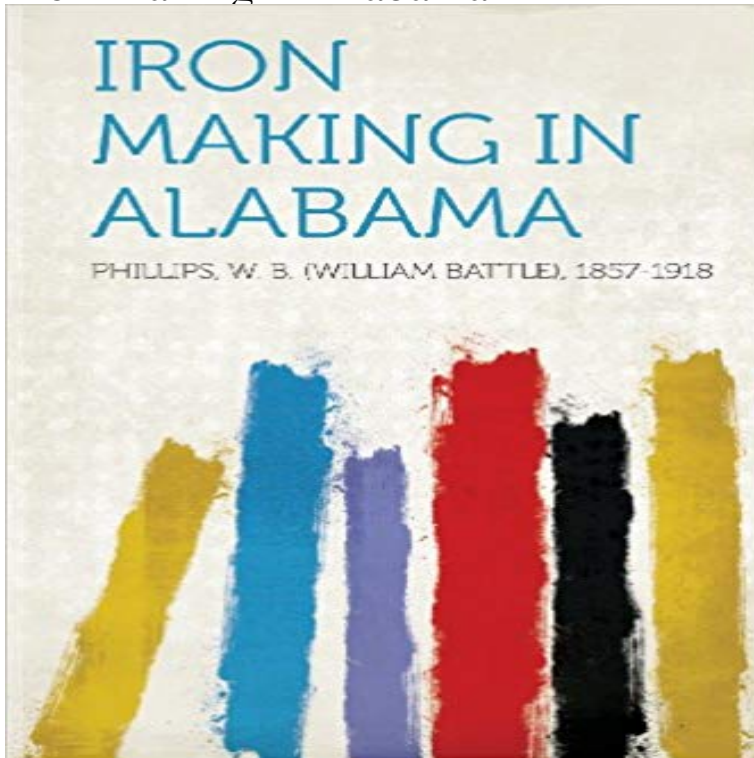


Iron Making in Alabama
