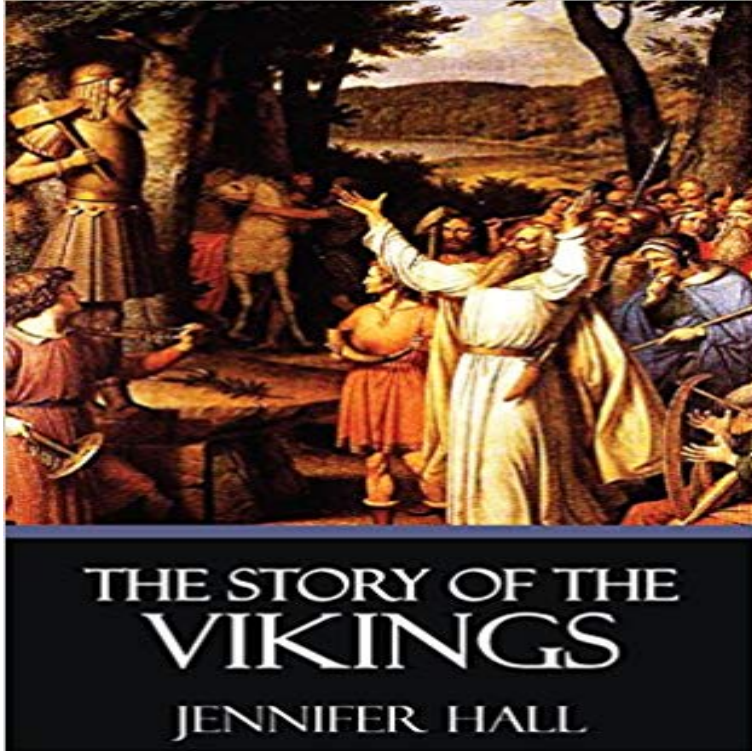


The Story of the Vikings [Quintessential Classics] [Illustrated]
