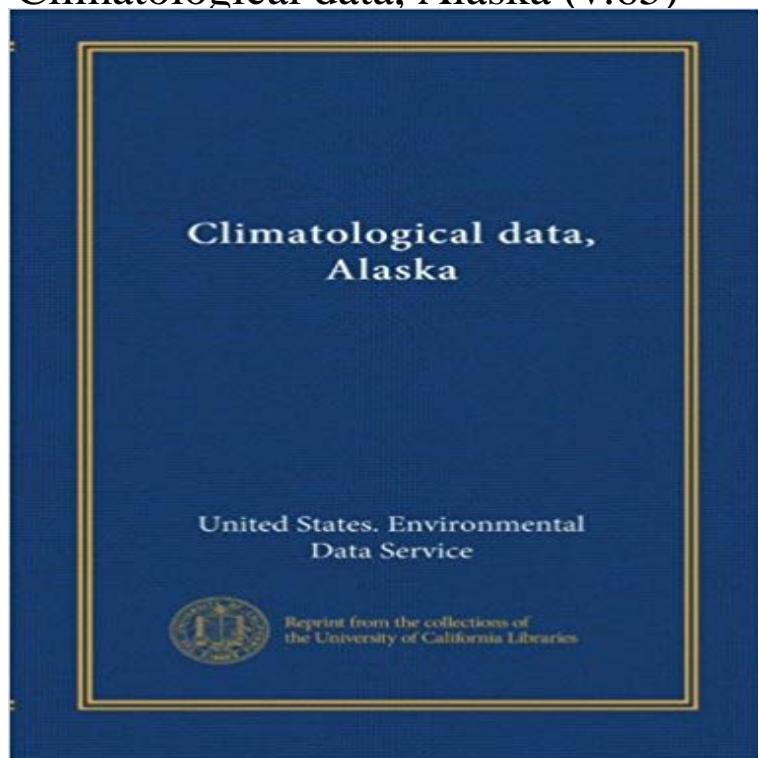


## Climatological data, Alaska (v.65)
