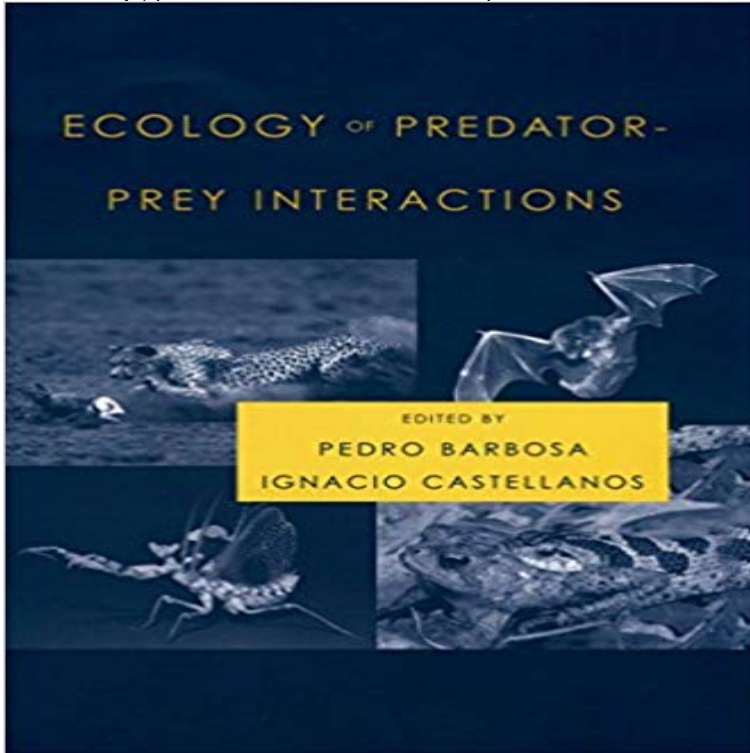


Ecology of Predator-Prey Interactions
