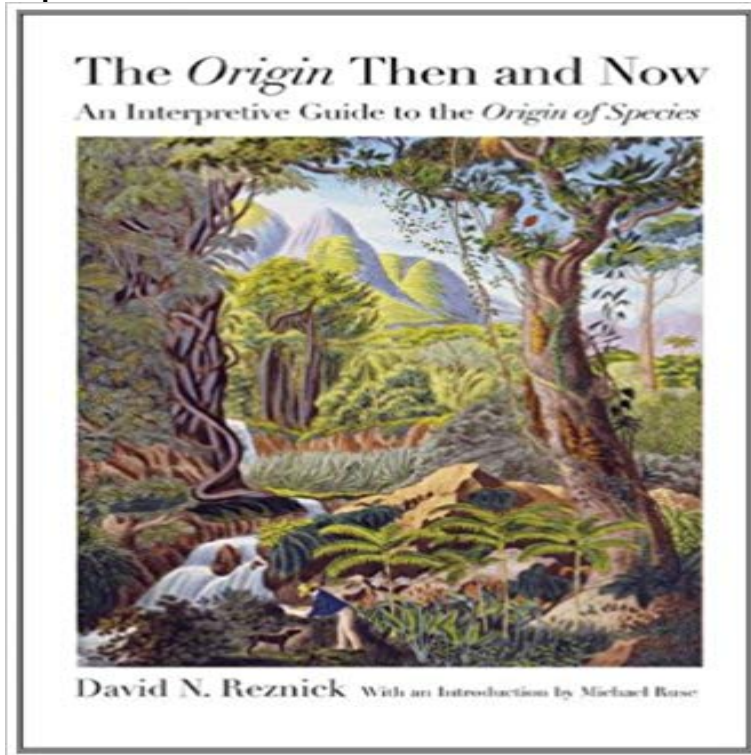


The Origin Then and Now: An Interpretive Guide to the Origin of Species
